In May 2025, EAA staff issued 28 water well construction permits consisting of:

- 4 exempt Edwards Aquifer domestic/livestock well permits;
- 2 alter or reconstruct an existing well permits;
- 2 well capping permits;
- 7 well plugging permits; and
- 6 "Drill Through the Edwards Aquifer" well permits.
