During the month of February 2023, field inspection and electronic technicians continued monitoring, collecting, and evaluating data received from 150 AMR sites through the ClearSCADA production server. Additionally, the team continued to collect and process annual groundwater withdrawal reports (AUR's) for irrigation, municipal, industrial, CPM and LPW users. The team also continues to collaborate with the compliance team in resolving unauthorized withdrawal's/LPW violations to ensure that end of year reports are made available to all owners who are required to report usage for 2022.
