Enclosed is one signed Amendment 1 to amend our joint-funding agreement for the Vulnerability Analysis for the Edwards and Trinity Aquifers Outcrop in Parts of Bexar and Comal Counties. The amendment increases funding from your agency by \$80,000. The amendment increases funding from the U.S. Geological Survey by \$40,000. The combined new total for this agreement is \$595,000. The purpose of this amendment is to assist with mapping out and building cross-sections across the Haby fault near Medina Lake.
