During the month of August 2022, field inspection and electronic technicians continued monitoring, collecting and evaluating data received from 143 AMR sites through our ClearSCADA production server, while performing preventive maintenance at these sites, and continued installing additional municipal/industrial AMR sites. Also, throughout the month, the team continued annual site visits to permitted irrigation wells/meters and continued to test meters as part of our four-year meter accuracy verification testing (MAVT). Additionally, the team collaborated with the compliance department in resolving unauthorized withdrawal violations.
