Following is a report of permit-related activities and informational items for July 2016:

1. Groundwater Withdrawal Transfers

In July, EAA staff completed processing of 23 transfers which consisted of the following:

2. Well Construction Program

- 3 exempt Edwards Aquifer domestic/livestock well permits;
- 1 Edwards Aquifer alter or reconstruct existing well permit (converted to an Austin Chalk/ Buda well);
- 1 well plugging permit; and
- 7 "Drill Through the Edwards Aquifer" new well permits.
