During the month of May, field inspection technicians continued troubleshooting AMR sites, logged data, updated PLC's with the latest firmware, and performed maintenance at all 59 AMR sites. Staff conducted several site visits to replace broken meters, and inspected two sites for possible steel flow tube modifications. Meter staff performed meter accuracy verification testing at 36 well/meter sites in Medina and Uvalde County during the month of April.
