

Agricultural Secondary Containment Assistance Program

What is the Agricultural Secondary Containment Assistance Program?

The Edwards Aquifer Authority (EAA) is introducing a program to financially assist with the secondary containment requirements found in Subchapter G of Section 713 for Aboveground Storage Tanks (AST). The Agricultural Secondary Containment Assistance Program (AgSCAP) offers landowners located on the Recharge Zone an opportunity to obtain funding for upgrading a portion or all of their AST system.

Who is eligible to participate?

Landowners that own or operate an AST located on the Recharge Zone are eligible to participate, as long as they have registered their tanks with the EAA by **December 31, 2017**. Registration may be completed:

How to participate in AgSCAP?

Information packets providing program details will go out in January 2018. Enclosed in that packet will be a form to sign and return indicating a willingness to participate. Any landowner who has registered their AST by **December 31, 2017**, will be eligible to participate in AgSCAP. Any available funding for upgrades will be allocated in 2019.
