In January, field inspection and electronic technicians continued troubleshooting, monitoring, collecting, and evaluating data received from 85 AMR sites through our ClearSCADA production server. Also, during this month, technicians have completed installation of firmware 1.17b at all 85 AMR sites. Additionally, the team has completed the review and entry of all annual groundwater withdrawal reports into our database that were due as of January 31, 2020. Permit holders who have failed to comply with the AUR submittal deadline will be contacted via e-mail, telephone calls, and site visits to get them to close out 2019 end of year reporting requirements before violations are referred to the Compliance department.
