Dear Limited Production Well Owner:

As 2020 draws to a close, it is again time to report the annual groundwater use from your limited production well (LPW). You can use the enclosed **2020 Annual Groundwater Use Report for Limited Production Wells** ("reporting form") the **EAA Meter Matters Smartphone App** ("Meter App"), or our on-line reporting tool to file your annual use with the EAA. If you use the enclosed reporting form, you should complete and return this form, along with your annual administrative fee payment by **January 31, 2021**.

If you are currently using, or would like to begin using the Meter App to report your groundwater use, a brochure is also enclosed with this letter with instructions and other useful information. You can use the Meter App to report your 2020 Year Ending meter reading and would not need the enclosed reporting form. In addition, you can report your use on-line at the EAA website, see the Groundwater Users tab, Reporting your Use.

Additionally, as a benefit to Meter App users beginning in 2020, if you submit quarterly and Year Ending meter readings as prompted by the App, your next year's LPW administration fee is waived!

Please recall that LPWs are authorized to withdraw up to **1.4 acre-feet** (or **456,191 gallons**) per calendar year for any beneficial use. It is very important that you maintain your withdrawals below this threshold in order to continue to qualify for LPW status.

Also find a **Contact Information Update Sheet** enclosed for you to complete if you find that any of the information on your reporting form is incorrect or requires updating. If needed, please complete and return the enclosed information sheet at your earliest convenience so that we may update our records.
