### SUMMARY:

The purpose of this agenda item is for the Aquifer Management Planning Committee to receive the second in a series of briefings from EAA staff in efforts to reconceptualize and optimize the EAA Recharge Program. This briefing will focus on updating recharge enhancement feasibility studies to current estimated project costs and capacities.
