**Receive report from EAA staff on the EAA's Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone Protection programs.**

STAFF RECOMMENDED MOTION:

SUMMARY:

The purpose of this agenda item is for the Permits/Enforcement Committee to receive a report from EAA staff regarding various Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone (EARZ) protection programs as they are outlined in Chapter 713 (Water Quality), Subchapters F (Regulated Substance Registration, Storage and Planning) and G (Aboveground and Underground Storage tanks) of the EAA's rules. Matters to be discussed include the scope of regulated activities on the EARZ and the applicable areas of the contributing zone.
